Basics tips for using the AVR

- Use Internet Explorer to access the PHIN AVR
- Add the PHIN AVR as a Trusted Site by doing the following:
 1. Go to Tools in the top task bar
 2. Click on Internet Options
 3. Go to the Security tab
 4. Click once on the Trusted Sites icon
 5. Click the Sites button
 6. Under "Add this web site to the zone" type <https://avr.phin.wisc.edu>
 7. Click Add
 8. Click OK
 9. Then OK again
- To avoid the "This page contains both secure and nonsecure items" warning when displaying contents from another site on the portal, do the following:
 1. Go to Tools in the top task bar
 2. Click on Internet Options
 3. Go to the Security tab
 4. Click on the Custom Level button
 5. Find "Display mixed content"
 6. Click Enable
 7. Click OK
 8. Click Yes when prompted
 9. Then click OK again
- Avoid using the browser Back button. In some cases, it can confuse the application. For example, when exploring an OLAP cube with Visual Data Explorer, right after a drill-down, if you use the browser Back button instead of the link in Drill Path to drill back up, the application would think you are still on the drill-down screen.

Exporting data

- If exporting data to Excel is blocked by Internet Explorer, go to Tools > Internet Options > Security tab. Click Trusted Sites if you have placed the PHIN AVR portal on the Trusted Sites zone. Click Custom Level button. Scroll down to the Downloads section and enable "Automatic prompting for file downloads."
