1. LRB 2435 Sale of Home Canned Produce(Tom or Mike)  
This bill provides that an individual who home processes or home cans fruits and vegetables that are acidic, that is, with an equilibrium pH value of 4.6 or lower, such as pickles, may sell the same at local community events, fairs, farmer's markets and the like, without necessitating a food processing plant license. Specific notice and labeling is required at the point of sale, and the income from such sales is limited to \$5,000 per year.

3. New revised process for agent evaluation
