4. **Evaluations (on-site audits of agents)**- We (DHS & DATCP) have met and created 2011 list and we are starting to make contacts and set-up mutually agreeable dates for evaluations.

Both Jefferson County (Tim Anderson) and Central Racine County are piloting and getting close to using Health Space for DATCP facilities.
